A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CHANGE ORDER TO A CONTRACT WITH REILLY SWEEPING, INC. FOR ADDITIONAL STREET SWEEPING SERVICES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter Section 6.04, the City Manager entered into a contract with Reilly Sweeping, Inc., as the lowest and best bidder, for annual spring street sweeping in an amount of \$12,000.00; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 18-5, adopted by this Council on January 23, 2018, the City Manager was authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Southeastern Equipment Company for the purchase of a commercial street sweeper at a total cost of \$242,190.88 to replace a vehicle at the end of its useful life; and

WHEREAS, instead of purchasing a new commercial street sweeper, staff has recommended a change order to the current contract with Reilly Sweeping, Inc. to allow the company to perform all scheduled program sweeping, contingent upon the success of a six-month pilot program, in an amount not to exceed \$25,800 for additional services during 2018; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds that it is necessary to amend the aforesaid contract in accordance with the recommendation of the City Manager to authorize additional funds as a change order for the addition of all scheduled program sweeping to the current contract with Reilly Sweeping, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: A change order in the amount of \$25,800 to the current street sweeping contract with Reilly Sweeping, Inc., is authorized.

<u>Section 2</u>: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3</u>: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
