

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH RONYAK PAVING, INC. FOR THE ANNUAL ASPHALT RESURFACING, RECONSTRUCTION AND NEW SURFACING PROGRAMS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, competitive bids were received for the 2015 Annual Asphalt Resurfacing and Reconstruction Program and new asphalt surfacing of parking areas and a trail at the City's Barlow Farm Park; and

WHEREAS, the City staff has recommended that the bid of Ronyak Paving, Inc. be accepted by this Council as being the lowest and best bid; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to accept the bid of Ronyak Paving, Inc. as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The bid of Ronyak Paving, Inc. for the 2015 Annual Asphalt Resurfacing and Reconstruction Program and new asphalt surfacing at Barlow Farm Park, being the lowest and best bid, is accepted and the City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Ronyak Paving, Inc. for the total amount of \$3,360,222.79 which includes a contingency amount.

Section 2. Although the majority of the funds necessary for the contract authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution have already been appropriated, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate \$238,183.14 from the carryover of funds from the 2013-14 Reconstruction programs (Fund 445) and \$268,700.12 from the Parks Fund to fund this contract.

Section 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to complete this public improvement project for the safety of the motoring and pedestrian public during the current construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
