

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE EQUIPMENT FROM MOTOROLA THROUGH THE HOMELAND SECURITY RADIO GRANT PROGRAM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 14-14 of this Council, passed on February 5, 2014, the City Manager was authorized and directed to apply for a County of Summit Homeland Security Radio Grant ("Grant") and, upon acceptance of the Grant, to enter into the Regional 800 MHz Radio System User Agreement; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to purchase the radio equipment from Motorola through the Grant Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into an agreement with Motorola for purchase of the radio equipment through the County of Summit Homeland Security Radio Grant Program in an amount not to exceed \$143,000, with this amount to be partially reimbursed through the Grant funds and the purchase to be made under the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program.

SECTION 2. The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper fund the additional amount of \$60,000 for purposes of making the payment for the equipment authorized in Section 1, which amount is to be reimbursed from the Grant funds.

SECTION 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure immediately necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety for the reason that it is necessary to have the appropriate safety service radio system to protect the citizens of the City of Hudson; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council, except that six (6) affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
