

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE VILLAGE OF BOSTON HEIGHTS FOR COOPERATION AND COST SHARING FOR THE RESURFACING OF WALTERS ROAD BETWEEN HINES HILL ROAD AND CORPORATION LINE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson (the “City”) and the Village of Boston Heights (the “Village”) recognize the need for the resurfacing of Walters Road between Hines Hill Road and the corporation line (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the City and the Village have agreed to cooperate in undertaking the Project and to share the costs associated with the resurfacing work; and

WHEREAS, the City finds that entering into an agreement with the Village for cooperation and cost-sharing will promote public health, safety, and welfare by improving roadway conditions and facilitating safe transportation; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with the Village outlining the terms of cooperation and cost-sharing responsibilities for the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the Village of Boston Heights for cooperation and cost-sharing in the resurfacing of Walters Road between Hines Hill Road and the corporation line, under terms and conditions deemed to be in the best interest of the City.

Section 2. The agreement shall specify the scope of work, cost-sharing arrangements, responsibilities of each party, and any other provisions necessary to carry out the Project efficiently.

Section 3. The Finance Director is authorized to make the necessary certifications and payments as required under the agreement, subject to the availability of funds and in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.

Section 4. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 6. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
