A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT THE STATE ROUTE 91 SOUTH SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT (PID# 106445) PLAN TO THE HUDSON PLANNING COMMISSION FOR REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION PURSUANT TO CHARTER SECTION 9.02.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 18-186, the City Council authorized the City to Enter into an LPA Agreement for funding with the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") as the Local Public Agency to perform substantial pedestrian and traffic improvements along SR 91 South Main Street from Barlow Road and Stoney Hill Drive in the City (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the Project includes the widening of the roadway for bike lanes, sidewalks, and a new center turn lane; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Hudson Charter Section 9.02, no street in the City of Hudson may be widened, narrowed, relocated, or its use changed unless City Council has first submitted the proposed street modification to the Hudson Planning Commission for its report and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, prior to moving forward with the Project, this Council requests that the Hudson Planning Commission, pursuant to Section 9.02 of the Hudson Charter, make a report and recommendation back to this Council with respect to the proposed Project's widening of the roadway for bike lanes, sidewalks, and a new center turn lane.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to submit a report detailing the street modifications that are contemplated with the State Route 91 South Safety Improvement Project (PID# 106445) to the Hudson Planning Commission for a report and recommendation pursuant to Hudson Charter Section 9.02.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3</u>: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
