

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PERRIN ASPHALT COMPANY FOR THE 2014 ASPHALT RESURFACING AND RECONSTRUCTION PROGRAM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, competitive bids were received for the 2014 Asphalt Resurfacing and Reconstruction Program; and

WHEREAS, the City administration has recommended that the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company in the amount of \$2,067,911.25 be accepted by this Council as being the lowest and best bid; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to accept the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company as being the lowest and best bid and to authorize additional work under the contract with Perrin based on the advantageous bid amount.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The bid of Perrin Asphalt Company for the 2014 Asphalt Resurfacing and Reconstruction Program in the amount of \$2,067,911.25, being the lowest and best bid, is accepted and the City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Perrin Asphalt Company in an amount not to exceed \$2,541,812.45, which includes additional work consisting of alternate streets added to the Program, City access roads and trails, and a Hudson City Schools parking lot, the cost of which will be reimbursed by the School District, as well as a 10% contingency amount on the original bid amount.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that the public road and facilities resurfacing and reconstruction must be made at the earliest possible time for the continued safety of the public and to complete the work during this construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
