

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ARCADIS FOR ENGINEERING DESIGN SERVICES FOR BRANDYWINE DRIVE AND BLACKBERRY DRIVE BRIDGES REHABILITATION PROJECTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson must perform rehabilitation projects on the Brandywine and Blackberry Drive bridges and the proposal for engineering design services for the projects from Arcadis was the best qualified submittal for the projects' designs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Arcadis for engineering design services for the Brandywine Drive and Blackberry Drive bridges rehabilitation projects in an amount not to exceed \$140,000.00.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account the funds necessary for the contract authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for these important public improvement projects to be designed and completed at the earliest possible time for the safety of persons traveling in the City; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
