

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH BLACK HORSE BRIDGE CONSTRUCTION, INC. FOR THE S.U.M.-BRANDYWINE DRIVE AND BLACKBERRY DRIVE BRIDGES REHABILITATION PROJECT OVER BRANDYWINE CREEK (P.I.D. 91974); AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson must perform a rehabilitation project on the Brandywine and Blackberry Drive bridges and competitively bid the contract for the rehabilitation labor and materials, whereby Black Horse Bridge Construction, Inc. has been determined to be the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Black Horse Bridge Construction, Inc. for labor and materials for rehabilitation of the Brandywine Drive and Blackberry Drive bridges project in an amount not to exceed \$932,047.60, which amount includes a 10% contingency for any unforeseen issues that may arise during the construction work.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account the funds necessary for the contract authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for this important public improvement project to be completed at the earliest possible time for the safety of persons traveling in the City; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
