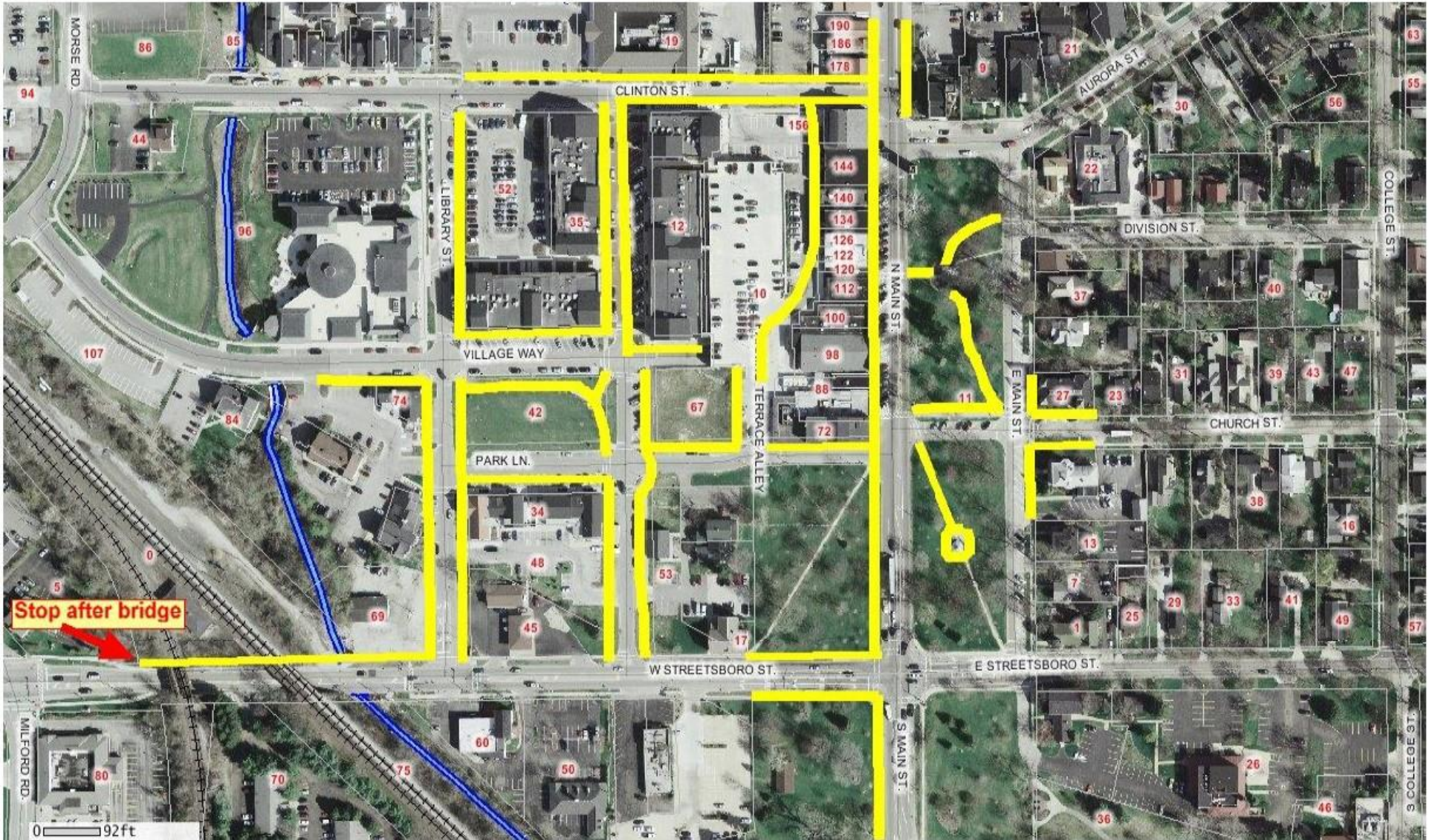

LOCATIONS OF WORK AREA

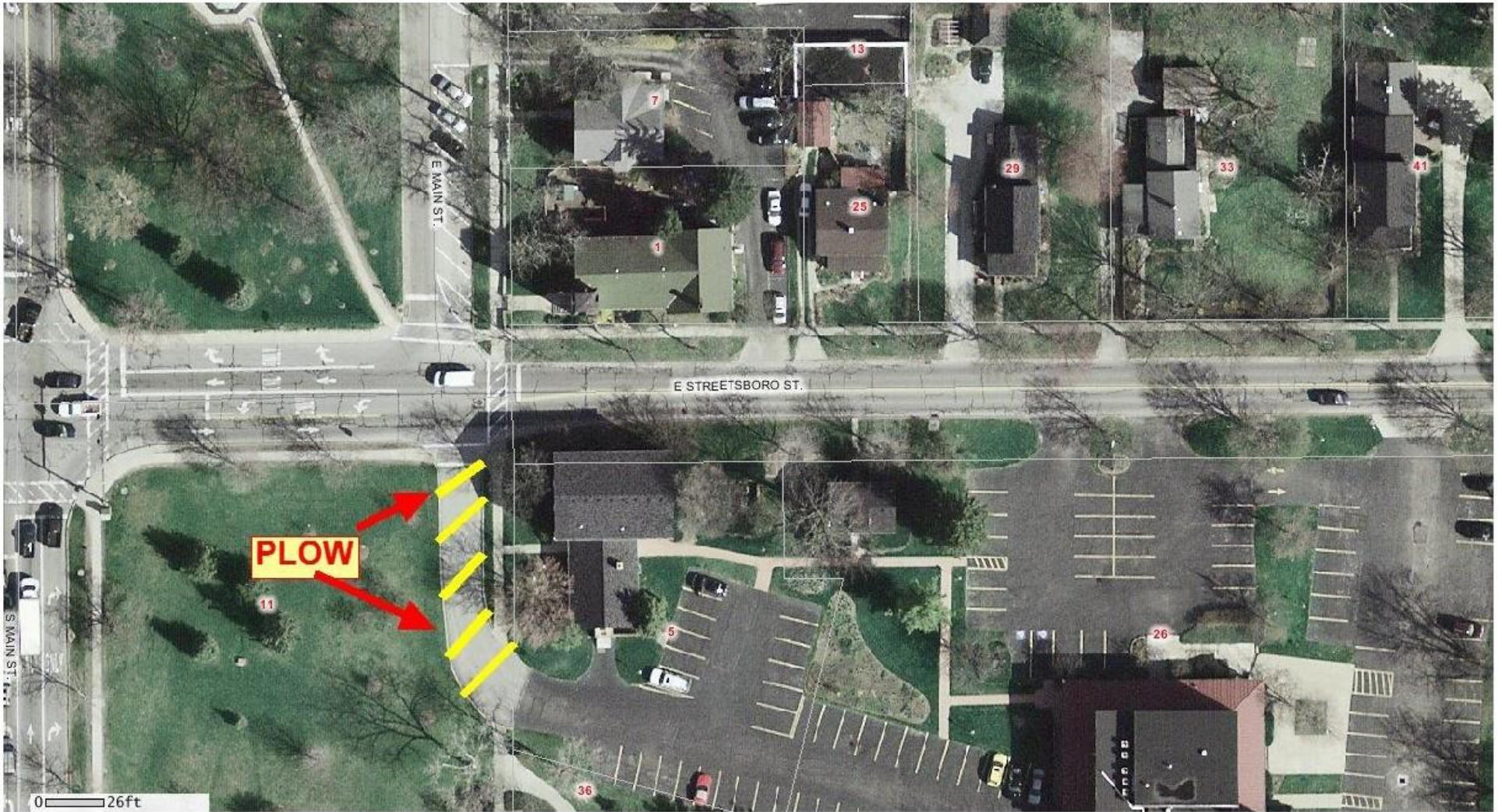

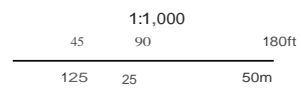

MEMORIAL GREEN (SOUTH EAST GREEN WALKING TRAIL)

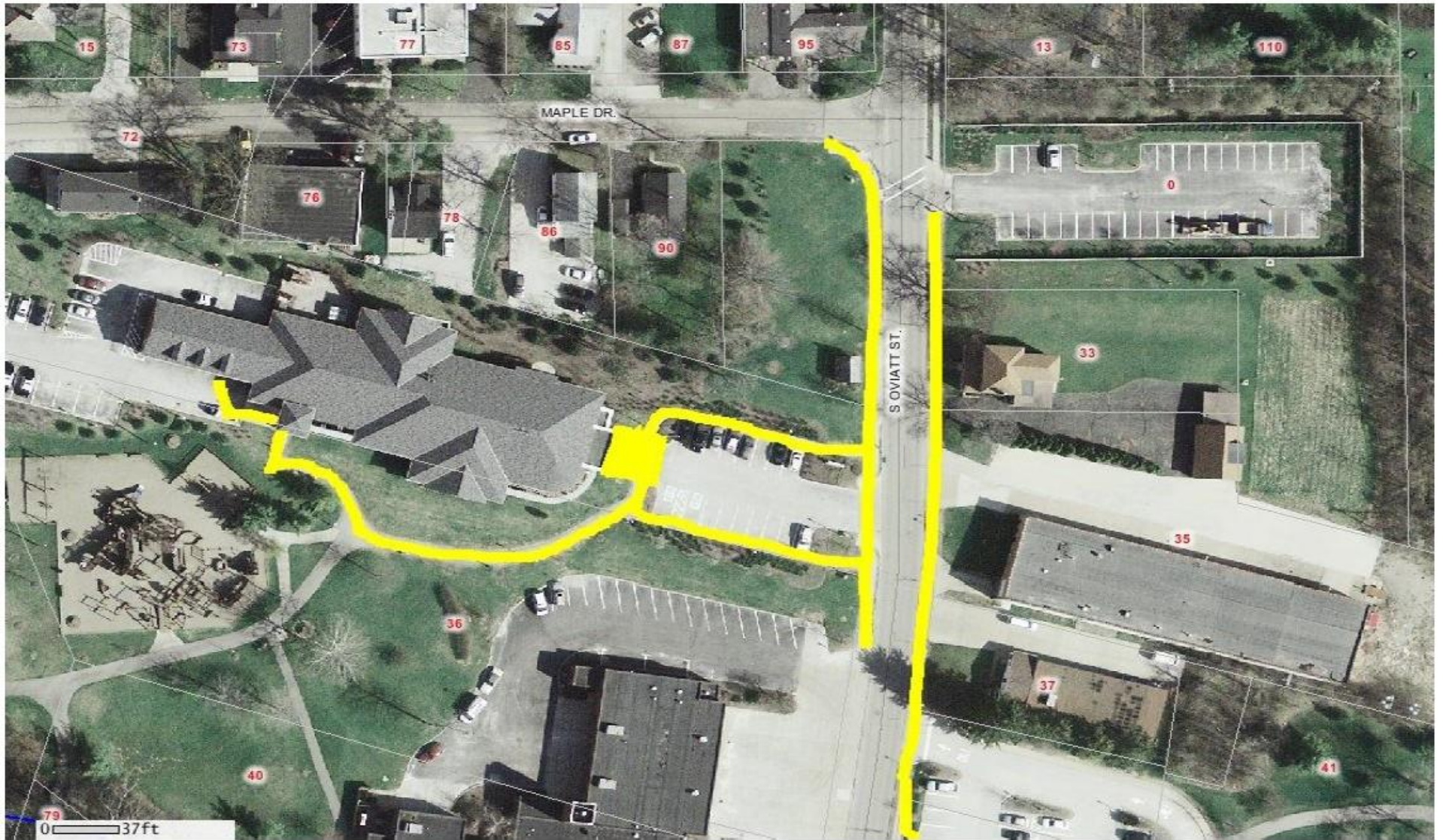

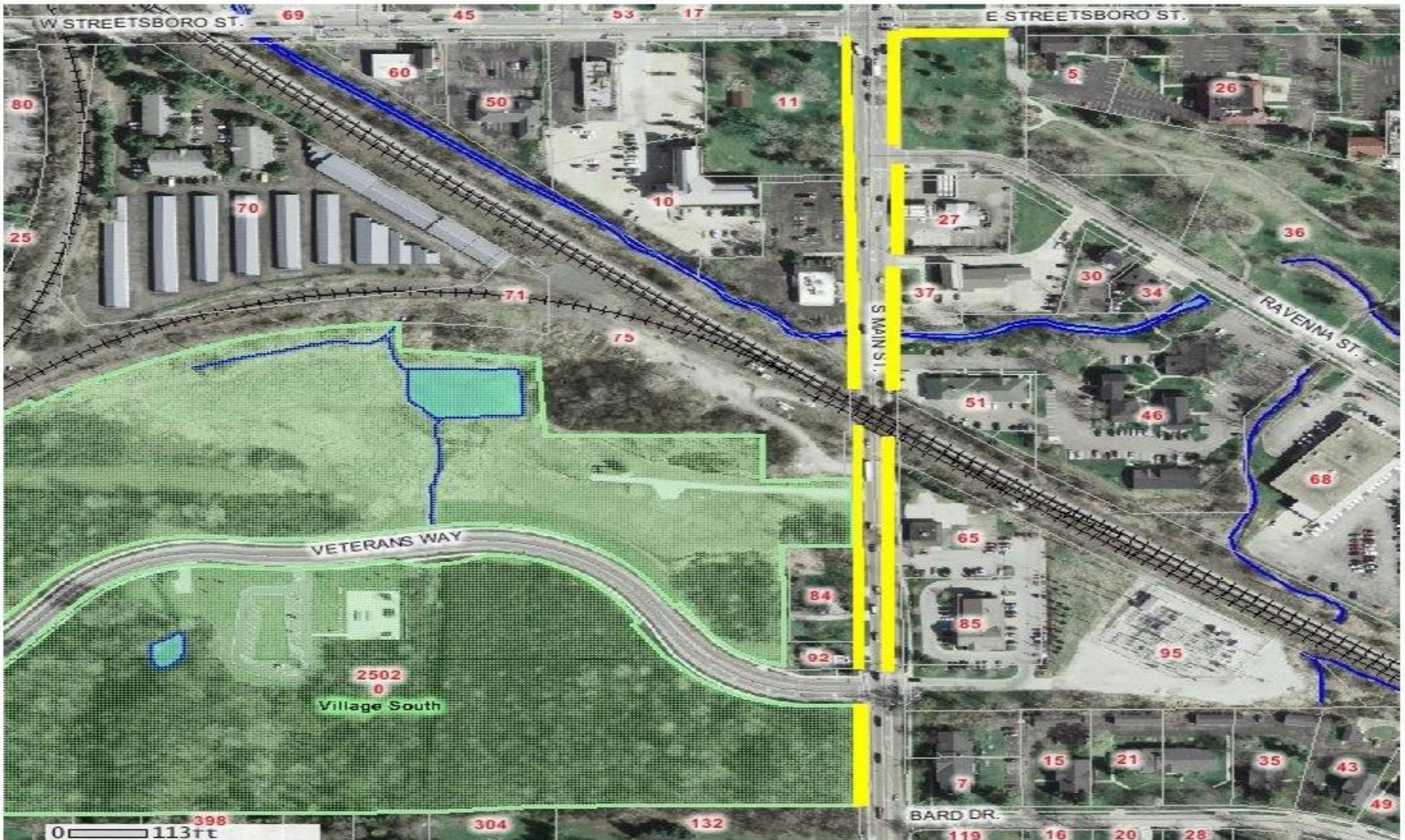
