

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH CENTURY EQUIPMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO GOLF COURSE FAIRWAY MOWERS.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson’s Ellsworth Meadows Golf Club has budgeted for the replacement of two (2) golf course fairway mowers to meet the needs of the golf course for the fast-approaching grass mowing season; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the City Charter and ordinances and under State law, the City Manager may purchase goods or services through the State Terms Schedule purchasing program (“STS”) when authorized by action of Council; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained a price quote from Century Equipment, an authorized State of Ohio STS vendor under State Term Contract #800261, for the purchase of two (2) golf course fairway mowers, which price quote is \$80,497.84.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into and execute on behalf of the City of Hudson a purchase agreement with Century Equipment for the purchase of two (2) fairway mowers at a total cost not to exceed Eighty Thousand Four Hundred Ninety-Seven Dollars and Eighty-Four Cents (\$80,497.84).

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
