AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 860.03 REGARDING LICENSING OF SNOW REMOVAL BUSINESSES TO MEET CURRENT OHIO REVISED CODE LIABILITY INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 4509.51, effective December 22, 2013, updated the minimum limits of liability insurance for motor vehicles in Ohio and Section 860.03(c), passed by this Council in 1996, established minimum insurance limits that do not meet the current Ohio Revised Code requirements; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend Codified Ordinance Section 860.03(c) to comply with the Ohio Revised Code minimum liability insurance limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. Subsection (c) only of Section 860.03, "License Required; Application; Insurance; Fee," of Chapter 860, "Snow Removal," of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Hudson is amended to hereinafter read as follows:

"860.03 LICENSE REQUIRED; APPLICATION; INSURANCE; FEE.

* * *

(c) No person shall be issued a license until the applicant deposits with the City Manager <u>proof of</u> a <u>current</u> policy of liability insurance <u>in a form acceptable to the City Manager with minimum coverage amounts</u> in the sum of <u>Twenty-Five</u> Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00 <u>25,000.00</u>) for injury to one person, <u>Forty Fifty</u> Thousand Dollars (\$40,000.00 <u>50,000.00</u>) for injury to more than one person, and <u>Ten Twenty-Five</u> Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00 <u>\$25,000.00</u>) for property damage arising out of any one accident through the operation of commercial snow removal machinery <u>and with minimum coverage amounts as required by state law for motor vehicles, in general, for or a commercial snow removal vehicle.</u>

<u>Section 2</u>. Current subsection (c) only of Section 860.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Hudson is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 3</u>. This Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council or its committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any
