A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR A DUMPSTER ENCLOSURE TO BE PLACED ON CITY LAND BEHIND THE MAIN STREET STORES IN THE DOWNTOWN AREA.

WHEREAS, The Farmers Rail (98 N Main) has been operating for some time with a dumpster placed adjacent to their rear loading dock, without an enclosure to screen and encroaching onto city property; and

WHEREAS, City staff have worked with the business for an extended period to find a solution that would contain the dumpster to private property including smaller dumpsters, revised relocations, and more frequent servicing without success; and

WHEREAS, this resolution would authorize the City Manager to enter into a license agreement with Farmers Rail of 98 North Main Street to permit a private dumpster enclosure to encroach into the city owned parcel associated with the parking terrace, similar to license agreements in effect for several of the North Main Street stores; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio that:

Section 1. That the above recitals and attached exhibit are fully incorporated herein.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to enter into a license agreement with Farmers Rail, 98 N. Main Street, Hudson, Ohio to permit a private dumpster enclosure to encroach onto City owned parcel associated with the parking terrace.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
