A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ADVERTISE FOR COMPETITIVE BIDS, AWARD AND TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE DRIVEWAY CULVERT AT 27 BARLOW ROAD.

WHEREAS, in the summer 2022, the Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT") finished the State Route 8 Reconstruction Project, which included roadway, pavement, bridge, lighting and drainage improvements along that highway and adjacent roadways in the cities of Cuyahoga Falls, Stow, and Hudson; and,

WHEREAS, as part of the project, ODOT reconstructed portions of the storm system in accordance with state and federal design requirements, including reconstruction the roadside culvert along Barlow Road, under State Route 8 from a 27" pipe to a 34" x 53" elliptical pipe meeting ODOT's design standards.

WHEREAS, during construction of the new storm pipe, Hudson City staff identified that the 15" driveway culvert at #27 Barlow Road, downstream of the new ODOT culvert, is undersized and in need of replacement; and,

WHEREAS, the work associated with removal and replacement of this drive culvert meets the following criteria established by the City's Private Property Storm Water Policy and Codified Ordinances:

- 1. The drainage issue is a nuisance and creates an unsafe condition.
- 2. The improvement would result in measurable flood reduction.
- 3. The contributing drainage area is over five (5) acres.
- 4. The work proposed exceeds the capacity of a resident to resolve; and,

WHEREAS, the new driveway culvert will be designed in-house by City staff and include new drive apron replacement, grading and restoration during the summer of 2023; and,

WHEREAS, the current estimated costs of construction of the project, including a 10% contingency, is \$80,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to advertise both for a period of at least once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation within the municipality and for a period of three (3) consecutive weeks on the Municipal website, requesting the submission of bids for the award and enter into a contract for the replacement of the driveway culvert at 27 Barlow Road in accordance with the specifications as supplied by the City Engineer's Office.

Section 2. The City Manager is authorized to sign all necessary documents and enter a contract or contracts on behalf of the City for the replacement of the driveway culvert at 27 Barlow Road in an amount to be appropriated by Council, subject to the affixing to the contract by the Finance Director of a certificate of availability of funds therefor, with the lowest and best bidder after receipt of such bids to the extent that such bid is not ten percent (10%) in excess of the Engineer's estimate.

Section 3. The City Manager is authorized to add a ten percent (10%) contingency amount to the contract with the lowest and best bidder.

<u>Section 4.</u> The City Manager is further authorized to return all certified checks and bid bonds submitted b the unsuccessful bidders and to reject all bids for said contract or contracts if deemed necessary to do so.

<u>Section 5.</u> That the above recitals and attached exhibit are fully incorporated herein.

Section 6. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 7. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
