OFFERED BY: MAYOR CURRIN

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE OHIO HISTORY CONNECTION FOR HUDSON CABLE TELEVISION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio History Connection provides grant funding on a 60/40 matching basis to assist history-minded organizations to preserve and share Ohio's history; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio History Connection could provide matching 60/40 grant funding of between \$2,000 and \$20,000 to Hudson Cable Television to fund an oral history project that will include interviews of notable Hudson residents.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1:</u> The City Manager is authorized to apply for a 60/40 matching grant to the Ohio History Connection for the reason set forth in the recitals to this Resolution.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the general welfare of the City and its residents for the reason that it is necessary to apply for this grant without delay to enhance the possibility of receiving the same; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
