A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PERRIN ASHPALT COMPANY, INC. FOR THE NORTON ROAD SIGHT DISTANCE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, competitive bids were received for the Norton Road Sight Distance Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the City staff has recommended that the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. be accepted by this Council as being the lowest and best bid; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to accept the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. as being the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The bid of Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. for the Norton Road Sight Distance Improvement Project, being the lowest and best bid, is accepted and the City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Perrin Asphalt Company, Inc. for the total amount of \$126,940.00 which includes the Base Bid, Alternates A and B, and a 10% contingency.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to complete this public improvement project for the safety of the motoring public during the current construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
