

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF AKRON FOR COOPERATION AND COST SHARING FOR THE RESURFACING OF MIDDLETON ROAD.

WHEREAS, the proposed project is to resurface Middleton Road from State Route 91 to Stow Road after the City of Akron's Water Main Rehabilitation Project is completed; and

WHEREAS, under an agreement between the two cities, the City of Hudson is taking the lead to enter into agreements for the resurfacing services work and to administer the same for the Middleton Road Resurfacing Project at a total cost not to exceed Three Hundred Fifty-Three Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Five Dollars (\$353,185.00), which this Council has appropriated; and

WHEREAS, the City of Akron would be responsible for fifty percent (50%) of the estimated project costs not to exceed One Hundred Seventy-Six Thousand Five Hundred Ninety-Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$176,592.50), which the City Council of Akron has previously appropriated by ordinance and which is to be reimbursed to the City of Hudson.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with the City of Akron for cooperation and cost sharing for the Middleton Road Resurfacing Project as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
