

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE CITY MANAGER'S ACCEPTANCE OF A SAFETY INTERVENTION GRANT FROM THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION ON BEHALF OF THE HUDSON EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson was awarded, and the City Manager recently accepted a Safety Intervention Program Grant from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation in the amount of \$37,217.36 to fund the purchase of a power ambulance cot and a power cot loading system. The City of Hudson's match will be \$12,405.78 (25%).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. This Council affirms the City Manager's acceptance of a grant from the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation in the amount of Thirty-Seven Thousand Two-Hundred Seventeen Dollars and Thirty-Six Cents (\$37,217.36) for the purpose set forth in the recital to this Resolution.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
