

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT RENEWAL FOR SNOW AND ICE CONTROL SERVICES ON CITY PROPERTIES.

WHEREAS, this Council passed Resolution No. 16-96 on June 7, 2016, authorizing a contract with H & M Snow Pros, Inc. for snow and ice control services on City properties for a term commencing November 1, 2016, and terminating May 31, 2018, with the option to extend the contract for two additional years beyond the initial contract term; and

WHEREAS, this Council passed Resolution No. 17-200 on December 27, 2017, authorizing staff to advertise for bids and/or obtain competitive pricing for goods and services during the year 2018 including bids for snow and ice control services on City properties; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the initial contract with H & M Snow Pros, Inc., the City has the right to renew the initial contract term for up to two additional years at its sole discretion; and

WHEREAS, City staff was satisfied with H & M Snow Pros' performance during the term of the initial contract; and

WHEREAS, H & M Snow Pros, Inc. has submitted renewal bid pricing for a renewal contract term commencing on November 1, 2018, and terminating on May 31, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the City finds the renewal pricing to be reasonable and wishes to renew the initial contract with H & M Snow Pros, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to renew the contract referenced above in the recitals for an additional two-year term with H & M Snow Pros, Inc. of Newbury, Ohio, for snow and ice control services on City properties for a term commencing November 1, 2018, and terminating May 31, 2020, in an amount to be specifically appropriated by Council.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution will take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
