A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH VIRTUAL DATAWORKS FOR THE ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION RENEWAL FOR THE CITYWIDE USE OF MICROSOFT 365.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Charter Section 6.04, the City Manager entered into a contract in 2020 with Virtual DataWorks for citywide use of Microsoft 365 software and associated professional support services; and

WHEREAS, the City staff has recommended that this Council authorize the City Manager to renew said contract with Virtual DataWorks on an annual basis for ongoing software and associated professional services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized to renew an existing contract with Virtual DataWorks for citywide use of Microsoft 365 software and associated professional support services for the 2021/2022 renewal period in an amount not to exceed Twenty-Six Thousand Eight Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$26,880.00).

Section 2. The City Manager is further authorized to renew the subject contract for annual renewal terms thereafter in an amount as appropriated by this Council and in a form acceptable to the City Manager and City Solicitor.

Section 3: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 4:</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
