OFFERED BY: MAYOR CURRIN

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE LOWE'S COMMUNITY PARTNERS GRANT PROGRAM FOR REPAIRS TO THE CITY CLOCK TOWER; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Lowe's Community Partners Grant Program assists local government with funding for needed structure renovations and upgrades; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended to this Council that it authorize a grant application for up to \$30,000 in funding to be applied toward roof repairs and replacement for the City's Clock Tower on the Village Green which is in dire need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to apply for financial assistance through the Grant Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Lowe's Community Partners Grant Program for a grant up to \$30,000 and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the Grant Program for the project described in the recitals to this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to submit the application for the grant by the deadline for submission of the same which is less than thirty days from the passage hereof; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
