

## **RESOLUTION NO. 14-87**

## A RESOLUTION HONORING SCOTT N. SCHROYER FOR THIRTY YEARS OF SERVICE WITH THE CITY OF HUDSON.

WHEREAS, Scott Schroyer began employment with the City of Hudson as a Seasonal Laborer on June 2, 1980, and he worked in the Service Department and at the Water Plant during the four summers that followed; and

WHEREAS, Scott began full-time employment on May 7, 1984, as a Maintenance Worker for the Service Department; and he was subsequently promoted to Assistant Superintendent for the Service Department in 1990; Engineering Assistant in 1995; Public Works Superintendent in 1999; Assistant Public Works Director in 2008; and Assistant City Manager in 2011; and

WHEREAS, Scott also served as the Interim Public Works Director during vacancies that occurred in 2006, 2007, and 2011; and he was appointed by City Council to serve as the Interim City Manager on November 20, 2013 until July 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, Scott has diligently served the residents of the community as a full-time employee for thirty years; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Council to recognize this significant achievement.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** Be It Resolved that the Council of the City of Hudson, Ohio, on behalf of itself and the residents of the City, expresses its thanks and gratitude to Scott Schroyer for more than thirty years of dedicated service with the City of Hudson and looks forward to many more.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this day be declared "Scott Schroyer Day in Hudson;" and in honor of his years of service, a memorial tree will be planted and a copy of this Resolution be presented to Mr. Schroyer.
