A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION BY THE CITY MANAGER TO THE HUDSON COMMUNITY FOUNDATION FOR A COVID-19 GRANT ON BEHALF OF HUDSON COMMUNITY TELEVISION.
