

ORDINANCE NO. 16-17

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 848.03 OF CHAPTER 848, "REFUSE HAULERS", OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO REGULATE THE ROUTING AND SCHEDULING OF COLLECTION OF SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING MATERIALS BY REFUSE HAULERS.

WHEREAS, as a component of City Council's Resolution providing for the designation of a preferred refuse hauler in the City through a contract with the City of Hudson and for the purpose of Hudson residents considering the use of such refuse hauler, City Council also requested that all refuse haulers licensed to operate in the City be limited to performing solid waste and recycling collection operations only on certain days of the week and within defined geographic areas for public health, safety and general welfare purposes; and

WHEREAS, City staff proposes to amend the current Codified Ordinance, Subsection 848.03(c), to provide for such regulation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Section 848.03, "Services to be Offered", of Chapter 848, "Refuse Haulers", of the Codified Ordinances is amended only at subsection (c) to read as follows:

(c) Collection by licensed refuse haulers shall be between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. ~~on the days scheduled.~~ **The City's Public Works Department shall specify in a written publication, as approved by the City Manager, the specific days of the week for all collection activities by licensed refuse haulers and the specific geographical areas of the Municipality where such activities may occur on a specific day of the week. The written publication provided for herein, and any amendments thereto, shall be served on all licensed refuse haulers at least seven (7) days in advance of the enforcement of the provisions thereof. All licensed refuse haulers shall comply with the written publication provided for in this division.**

Section 2. Subsection 848.03(c) as it existed prior to the effective date of this Ordinance is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
