
This house was home to four generations of Ellsworths, covering a period of 81 years. It is a throwback in style, more Greek Revival than any style of its period.

The center chimney was removed in a 1937 remodeling, but the original woodwork and flooring remain in the main core of the house. Extensive remodeling in the 1960s.
