

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 22-53 AND THE INTERCONNECTION POLICY FOR CONNECTION OF RESIDENTIAL AND/OR COMMERCIAL SOLAR POWER GENERATION SYSTEMS TO THE CITY OF HUDSON'S POWER GRID.

WHEREAS, the City staff has reviewed the current language for Hudson Public Power customers returning surplus energy to the City's electric grid; and,

WHEREAS, the City staff recommends language changes to the Interconnection Policy for the connection of residential and/or commercial solar power generation systems to the City of Hudson's power grid, amending the metering arrangement and billing language to industry standards; and,

WHEREAS, it is determined by this Council that the Interconnection Policy for Hudson Public Power shall be amended as recommended, as the changes will improve and clarify the Interconnection Policy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. As detailed in "Exhibit A," which is attached hereto and incorporated herein, this Council hereby amends the amendment to the Interconnection Policy, which was last amended by the passage of Ordinance 22-53, in order to: (a) amend the metering arrangement and billing language; and, (b) as otherwise reviewed and approved by Hudson Public Power.

Section 2. To the extent any prior Ordinance, exhibit, and/or Interconnection Policy conflicts with the terms of this Ordinance, the prior Ordinance, exhibit, and/or Interconnection Policy are hereby repealed, rescinded and replaced.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
