A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES FOR AN EMS PRIORITY ONE TRAINING AND EQUIPMENT GRANT ON BEHALF OF HUDSON EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services ("EMS"), provides a grant to assist emergency medical service organizations with the purchase of approved training and equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of EMS could provide an EMS Priority One Training and Equipment Grant to fund training and/or equipment listed on the Training and Equipment List/Expenditures Form as approved by the Ohio Emergency Medical, Fire, and Transportation Services ("EMFTS") Board, with no matching funds required of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager's designee has submitted a Grant application for said purpose to the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of EMS.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: Council hereby affirms the actions of the City Manager's designee to execute and file a grant application with the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of EMS, for funding of training and/or equipment listed on the Training and Equipment List/Expenditures Form as approved by the Ohio EMFTS Board, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3:</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
