A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH VIZMEG LANDSCAPE FOR VILLAGE GREENS AND PUBLIC PROPERTIES LANDSCAPING MAINTENANCE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, pursuant to competitive bidding, the Department of Public Works has recommended that the bid of Vizmeg Landscape is the lowest and best bid for a contract for lawn care, fertilization, trash receptacle, etc. services at City-owned Village Greens and other City properties for a two (2)-year period from January 1, 2014 through December 31, 2015.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a two (2)-year agreement with Vizmeg Landscape for a term to begin January 1, 2014 and to run through December 31, 2015, in the annual amount of \$31,461.00 with a 15% contingency amount for a total of \$36,180.00 per year, subject to an appropriation from this Council for each year.

Section 2: Council finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council and any of its committees concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in an open meeting of this Council or its committees, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, all in compliance with the law.

Section 3: This Resolution will take effect and be in force from and after the earliest
