

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE TO SUMMIT COUNTY REWORKS FOR A COMMUNITY RECYCLING ASSISTANCE GRANT ON BEHALF OF THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT.

WHEREAS, Summit County ReWorks (ReWorks) offers funding to municipalities through the Community Recycling Assistance Grant Program (the "Grant") to support projects which would sustain and increase recycling activities within Summit County; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson is eligible for \$22,262.00 in Grant funding from ReWorks; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager's designee submitted an application to ReWorks for said Grant in the amount of \$22,262.00 to help defray the costs of contracted leaf collection services and related costs during the current calendar year; and

WHEREAS, if the Grant is awarded, no matching funds will be required of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. Council hereby supports and affirms the action of the City Manager's designee to submit an application to ReWorks, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for funding assistance under the Grant program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
