A RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING AND RATIFYING THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE'S SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION TO THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION FOR A SAFETY INTERVENTION GRANT ON BEHALF OF HUDSON EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation awards Safety Intervention Grant funding for the purpose of substantially reducing or eliminating injuries associated with a particular task or operation; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson is eligible for up to \$40,000 every three years in Safety Intervention Grant funding; and,

WHEREAS, Hudson Emergency Medical Services is eligible to use this funding for the purchase of two stairs with a design that would facilitate moving patients both up and down stairs, thereby helping to alleviate strain caused by lifting; and,

WHEREAS, the total cost of chairs is estimated at approximately \$33,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, grant funding is based on a 3 to 1 match, and the City of Hudson's match would therefore only be approximately \$8,250.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

- <u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager and/or his designee is retroactively authorized to apply to the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for a safety intervention grant on behalf of Hudson Emergency Medical Services and all such official conduct related to the same is hereby ratified.
- Section 2. This Resolution is effective as of March 16, 2023, the date of the City's application.
- Section 3. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.
- Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
