

RESOLUTION NO. 21-119

A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING ACCEPTANCE BY THE CITY MANAGER'S DESIGNEE OF AN EMS PRIORITY ONE TRAINING AND EQUIPMENT GRANT FROM THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES, ON BEHALF OF HUDSON EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, this Council passed Resolution No. 21-43 on April 20, 2021, affirming submission by the City Manager's designee of an EMS Priority One Training and Equipment Grant application to the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of Emergency Medical Services ("EMS") to fund training and/or equipment listed on the Training and Equipment List/Expenditures Form as approved by the Ohio Emergency Medical, Fire, and Transportation ("EMFTS") Board; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager's designee has accepted an EMS Priority One Training and Equipment Grant from the Ohio Department of Public Safety, Division of EMS, on behalf of Hudson EMS, in the amount of Three Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars and Twenty-Four Cents (\$3,562.24), and no matching funds are required of the City; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to affirm the acceptance of said grant.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: This Council affirms acceptance by the City Manager's designee of an EMS Priority One Training and Equipment Grant in the amount of Three Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Two Dollars and Twenty-Four Cents (\$3,562.24) to be used by Hudson EMS for the purpose set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
