

RESOLUTION NO. 16-79

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SOLICIT REQUESTS FOR PROPOSALS FOR THE FINAL DESIGN AND ASSOCIATED PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR RELOCATION OF THE CITY'S SALT DOME AND THE SCHOOL DISTRICT BUS GARAGE FACILITY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City administration is requesting this Council's approval to solicit proposals for the final design and associated professional services needed for relocation of the City's salt dome and the school district's bus garage facilities as part of Phase II of the Downtown Redevelopment Project; and

WHEREAS, based upon the proposals that are received, the City administration will return to Council with a recommendation to award a contract to the most qualified firm.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to solicit, receive and review proposals for the final design and associated professional services for relocation of the City's salt dome and the School District's bus garage facilities.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to solicit proposals for the works set forth in the recitals to this Resolution in order to move forward with Phase II of the downtown redevelopment project; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council, except that six (6) affirmative votes shall be required if all members of Council are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
