AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CODIFIED ORDINANCE SECTION 860.03 REGARDING LICENSING OF SNOW REMOVAL BUSINESSES TO MEET CURRENT OHIO REVISED CODE LIABILITY INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS.
