

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH REILLY SWEEPING INCORPORATED FOR STREET SWEEPING SERVICES.

WHEREAS, competitive bids were solicited for ongoing street sweeping services for City roads and properties, Reilly Sweeping Incorporated was determined to have submitted the lowest and best bid, and its services in the past have been satisfactory.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract on behalf of the City, subject to the affixing to the contract by the Director of Finance of his certificate of availability of funds therefor, with Reilly Sweeping Incorporated in an amount not to exceed Thirty-Four Thousand Three Hundred Seventy-Nine Dollars (\$34,379.00) per year for a term of two years with the option for the City Manager to renew the contract for an additional two-year term in an amount to be subsequently appropriated by this Council.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
