

RESOLUTION NO. 14-90

OFFERED BY: MAYOR CURRIN

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH NERONE & SONS, INC. FOR THE DIVISION STREET SANITARY SEWER AND WATER LINE IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson is performing a sanitary sewer and water line improvement project in the Division Street area of the City and, pursuant to law, requested competitive bids for the construction of the project, whereby no bids were received for its first publication and only one bid was received for its re-bid of the contract, that being from Nerone & Sons, Inc., which is determined to be an acceptable contractor with an appropriate bid for this project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Nerone & Sons, Inc. for the construction of the Division Street sanitary sewer and water line improvement project in an amount not to exceed \$542,312.41, which amount includes an additional 10% contingency amount.

Section 2: The Director of Finance is authorized and directed to appropriate to a proper account the funds necessary for the contract authorized in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary for this important sanitary sewer and water main improvement project to be completed at the earliest possible time so as to continue to provide critical sanitary sewer and potable water services to City property owners and residents and to do so within this construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
