

Further Description of Important Features Single off-center entrance, with pediment, to south; hip roof; brackets; typically 1850-60's windows with narrow mullions, pedimented lintels; Greek Revival influence in entrance door, outside window trim and inside window of original kitchen and dining room. 1873 addition is present kitchen and former woodshed, storage area above, built over crawl space, foundation sunk 3"-10" along north side. Garage converted to family room c. 1965, plus fireplace addition to study. Roof of addition raised 1970's; back porch added.</p> <p>3. History and Significance Elizabeth Shaw was the wife of Calvin Shaw, a carpenter, who came to Hudson from Massachusetts in 1865.</p> <p>4. 



