A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A TWO-YEAR CONTRACT FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND INSPECTION SERVICES WITH QUALITY CONTROL INSPECTIONS, INC.

WHEREAS, pursuant to a request for proposals, this Council wishes to authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement with Quality Control Inspections, Inc. based on its proposal being the most appropriate proposal for professional construction management and/or inspection services for various City capital improvement projects and inspections of private developments from March 2, 2020, to March 1, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with Quality Control Inspections, Inc.
