A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PERRIN ASPHALT COMPANY FOR ALTERNATE WORK TO THE 2013 CONCRETE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to public advertisement, the bid of Perrin Asphalt Company for Alternate Work for the 2013 Concrete Replacement Program has been determined to be the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The bid for the Alternate Work for the 2013 Concrete Replacement Program by Perrin Asphalt Company, being the lowest and best bid, is hereby awarded and the City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Perrin Asphalt Company therefor in an amount not to exceed \$95,472.59.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that concrete repairs to the City's public ways must be made at the earliest possible time for the continued safety of the public and to complete concrete replacement in the City during this construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
