### CITY OF HUDSON VARIANCE NOTES FOR JULY 2013 FINANCIAL REPORT

### **REVENUE:**

### 2012 Year-To-Date (YTD) vs. 2013 YTD Actual

Real and Personal Property Taxes are down \$366,000 due to the County advance of \$400,000 in 2012 vs. \$100,000 in 2013. We are \$40,000 ahead of estimate.

Income Tax revenues are \$606,000 higher due in part to timing differences and payments from individuals in December 2012 (paid to the City in January 2013) that were not made in the prior year. We've had several increases in year over year net profit collections to offset a large refund (approx. \$285,000). We also have a few larger employers with increased withholding taxes and a few new smaller companies that started up their business in 2013. We were down approx. \$15,000 for the month of July.

Overall, withholding taxes are up 7.5%, Individual taxes are up 9.8% and Net Profit taxes are up 3.2%. Including Parks, Fire, EMS and Hudson Schools, income taxes are up \$809,000 or 7.5%. Below is a comparison of income tax revenue by category:

*Local Government* is \$140,000 lower in 2013 due to cuts in state funding. The cuts were anticipated and we are \$970 below budget.

Estate Tax revenue is \$247,000 lower in 2013 due to a lower estate settlement for the first half of 2013. We conservatively estimated \$400,000 for ½ year and we are \$238,000 ahead of budget.

*Interest Income* is \$98,000 lower due to reduced interest rates; as higher yield investments matured, they were replaced with lower yields.

**Transfers In, Advances and Reimbursements** are \$75,000 above estimate primarily due to a \$64,000 worker's comp refund that was not anticipated at the beginning of the year.

Cable TV is \$150,000 lower in 2013 due to a \$75,000 advance from the General Fund in January 2012 to pay for the camera replacements and the earlier receipt of the 2012 franchise fee (timing).

*Parks* is \$69,000 lower in 2013 due to \$25,000 in donations for Veteran's Way Park in 2012 plus the timing of the income tax proceeds to the golf course – a lump sum was made in 2012 vs. monthly in 2013.

Fire Department revenue is \$71,000 higher in 2013 primarily due to increased income tax revenue.

*Ellsworth Meadows* is \$37,000 lower in 2013 due the timing of the transfer from Parks. It was done in one lump sum in 2012 vs. monthly in 2013. Excluding the impact of the transfer, revenue is up \$5,000 through July 2013 vs. 2012 mainly due to a \$12,000 beverage cart rebate.

### **EXPENDITURES:**

### 2012 YTD Actual vs. 2013 YTD Actual

General Fund total expenditures decreased \$371,000 through July 2013 as compared to July 2012. The largest decreases were Community Development \$138,000 due to severance pay in 2012 and vacancies in 2013 and Public Properties \$137,000 primarily due to the elimination of YDC maintenance costs.

Street Maintenance & Repair expenditures are \$264,000 higher in 2013 primarily due to \$81,000 in severance pay in 2013; \$21,000 in a timing difference in fleet charges and \$126,000 increase in salt purchases.

**Parks Fund** expenditures are \$675,000 lower in 2013 primarily due to payments for the Veteran's Way Park project and the \$100,000 transfer to the golf course fund in 2012.

Cable TV Fund expenditures are \$129,000 lower in 2013 due to \$204,000 expended for replacement cameras in 2012 offset by \$41,000 purchase of a video switcher in 2013.

**EMS Fund** expenditures are \$63,000 lower in 2013 due to a vehicle and equipment purchases in 2012 totaling \$60,000.

**Storm Water Fund** expenditures are \$169,000 lower in 2013 primarily due to \$173,000 in payments for the Barlow Community Center pond in 2012.

*Fleet* expenditures are \$337,000 lower in 2013 due to \$310,000 reduction in vehicle purchases in 2013 vs 2012.

### 2013 YTD Actual vs. 2013 Budget

Revenues are within a reasonable variance range with the exception of income taxes, estate taxes and transfers, advances and reimbursements as discussed above. The increased income taxes positively impacted **General, Parks, Fire and EMS** revenue variances; interest income continues to be below estimate. Expenses are generally favorable or within a reasonable range of budget with the exception of the Administration budget from the move to MSC and **RITA** fees are below budget due to better than expected income tax revenue. **Community Development** is below budget due to unfilled vacancies. Transfers Out is \$410,000 below budget due to the transfer for the Middleton Road paving project. This project was subsequently delayed until 2014. **Parks, Fire, Wastewater and Electric** have larger favorable expense variances due to timing of charges that should normalize over time.
