

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR HIS
DESIGNEE TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR A REWORKS
COMMUNITY ASSISTANCE RECYCLING GRANT (CRAG).**

WHEREAS, the City Administration seeks funding from the Summit County Reworks through the Community Recycling Assistant Grant (CRAG) to support residential infrastructure for recycling or organics diversion within Summit County communities; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Community Recycling Assistant Grant (CRAG) is to support residential infrastructure for recycling or organics diversion within Summit County communities; and

WHEREAS, if the grant is awarded, the City will accept the grant funding and use it for the intended purposes to offset personnel costs associated with the annual fall leaf pick up; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be determined at the end of the fiscal year, with no matching funds required from the City; and

WHEREAS, the submission of an application for this program and the City's efforts to pursue and support recycling are in the best interest of the City and its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. That the City Manager or designee is authorized to submit an application to the FY26 Reworks Community Recycling Assistance Grant (CRAG) on behalf of the City of Hudson and any actions taken to date in this regard are hereby retroactively affirmed and ratified.

Section 2. That, in the event the City is awarded the grant, the City Manager and/or his designee are hereby authorized to accept such an award and do all things necessary to process and use such funding for the purposes set forth herein and consistent with the program's guidelines.

Section 3. That the aforesaid recitals are rendered to be the findings of this Council and are hereby incorporated into this Resolution.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from after the earliest period allowed by law.
