

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH PERK COMPANY, INC. FOR THE STATE ROUTE 8 CONCRETE ROAD PANEL REPLACEMENT PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to public advertisement, the bid of Perk Company, Inc. for the State Route 8 Concrete Road Panel Replacement Project has been determined to be the lowest and best bid.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The bid for the Concrete Road Panel Replacement Project by Perk Company, Inc., being the lowest and best bid, is hereby accepted and the City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Perk Company, Inc. therefor in an amount not to exceed \$69,839, which amount includes a base bid of \$46,987, an alternate bid of \$16,503 and a 10% contingency amount of \$6,349.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare and for the further reason that concrete panel replacement to the highways located in the City must be made at the earliest possible time for the continued safety of the public and to complete the replacement in the City during this construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
