A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING THE APPLICATION SUBMITTED BY THE CITY MANAGER TO THE OHIO BUREAU OF WORKERS' COMPENSATION FOR A SAFETY INTERVENTION PROGRAM GRANT.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation (OBWC) provides Safety Intervention Program Grant funding to Ohio public employers who wish to purchase equipment to substantially reduce or eliminate injuries and illnesses associated with a particular task or operation; and

WHEREAS, the OBWC could provide up to approximately \$1,971.75 in Safety Intervention Program Grant funding on a 75% (OBWC) to 25% (City) matching basis to assist with the purchase of a magnetic manhole cover lift system for use by the City's Electric Department and Service Department employees to reduce the potential for injuries to backs, fingers, and toes; and

WHEREAS, if said grant is awarded, the required matching amount will be funded by the City's Electric Department; and

WHEREAS, the OBWC will award grant funding on a first come first served basis, and the City Manager has submitted a grant application to increase the likelihood of receiving funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1:</u> Council hereby affirms the City Manager's actions to execute and file an application with the Ohio Bureau of Workers' Compensation for a Safety Intervention Program Grant, having provided all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance under the Safety Intervention Program as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution.

Section 2: It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3:</u> This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
