

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH ASPHALT FABRICS AND SPECIALTIES, INC. FOR THE 2015 ROAD CRACKSEALING PROGRAM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, competitive bids were received for the City’s road cracksealing program; and

WHEREAS, the City administration has recommended that the bid of Asphalt Fabrics and Specialties, Inc. be accepted by this Council as being the lowest and best bid and to add to the contract \$26,250 in alternate work as explained to this Council; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to accept the bid of Asphalt Fabrics and Specialties, Inc. as being the lowest and best bid and to approve the amount of the alternate work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The bid of Asphalt Fabrics and Specialties, Inc. for the 2015 road cracksealing program in the amount of \$93,316.00, plus \$26,250.00 for alternate work, for a total contract amount of \$119,566.00 is accepted and the City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Asphalt Fabrics and Specialties, Inc. for said amount.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to complete this public improvement project for the safety of the motoring public during the current construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
