A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH PETERS, TSCHANTZ & ASSOCIATES FOR THE FINAL DESIGN, BID SPECIFICATIONS AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT TASKS FOR THE DARROW ROAD STREET LIGHTING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City Manager and Public Works Department have recommended that based upon past professional services performed by the firm of Peters, Tschantz & Associates with respect to evaluating the roadway lighting conditions on Darrow Road from Barlow Road to Norton Road, it is the most appropriate firm to perform the final design, bid specifications and project management tasks for a lighting improvement project on Darrow Road.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Peters, Tschantz & Associates in an amount not to exceed \$67,600 for the work set forth in the preamble to this Resolution.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to complete this public improvement project for the safety of the general public and to do so during the current construction season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
