

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR HER DESIGNEE, TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO GEORGIA-PACIFIC FOR A BUCKET BRIGADE GRANT TO BENEFIT THE HUDSON FIRE DEPARTMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Georgia-Pacific helps fire departments in communities near Georgia-Pacific facilities by providing Bucket Brigade Grants to fund equipment and resources needed to promote safe, efficient and effective operations; and

WHEREAS, Georgia-Pacific could provide up to \$10,000 in funding through a Bucket Brigade Grant for the purchase of necessities, such as turnout gear, breathing apparatus, water pumps, hoses, or nozzles, needed in the Hudson Fire Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager, or her designee, is authorized to apply to Georgia-Pacific for a Bucket Brigade Grant for up to \$10,000 for the reason set forth in the recitals to this Resolution.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare of the City and its residents and for the reason that it is necessary to apply for this grant without delay to timely meet the deadline for submission of the application and to enhance the possibility of receiving the same; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council, except that six affirmative votes shall be required if all members are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
