A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CARDINAL ASPHALT INC. FOR THE CONSTRUCTION AND/OR PAVING OF VARIOUS TRAILS, PATHS, ROADWAYS AND DRIVEWAYS ON PUBLIC PROPERTIES.

WHEREAS, competitive bids were received for the paving or resurfacing of various trails, paths, roadways, and driveways on public properties within the City's cemeteries, Water Division, and golf course; and

WHEREAS, the City staff has recommended that the bid of Cardinal Asphalt Inc. be accepted by this Council as being the lowest and best bid and that certain alternate work be performed; and

WHEREAS, this Council wishes to accept the bid of Cardinal Asphalt Inc. as being the lowest and best bid and to accept alternate work as recommended by staff.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The bid of Cardinal Asphalt Inc. for the paving of various trails, paths, roadways and driveways on public properties, being the lowest and best bid, is accepted and the City Manager is authorized to enter into a contract with Cardinal Asphalt Inc. for the total amount of \$737,694.93, which includes amounts for contingencies relating to scope of services changes that may occur and for alternate work as recommended by City staff.

<u>Section 2.</u> It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

<u>Section 3.</u> This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
