Subj: Individual Landmarks


Background on Individual Landmarks

- AHBR has the authority to recommend to Planning Commission and City Council buildings and structures which should be designated historic landmarks.
- A Certificate of Appropriateness is required for any alteration or demo of a historic landmark.
- Therefore, to prevent future demolitions of historic structures outside the district, those structures would have to be formally accepted as individual landmarks.
- The last major effort to designate individual landmarks occurred 1998-2002. HHA, AHBR and the City Staff compiled a list of 173 potential structures.
- Of those 173 structures, 24 were designated. The program was completely voluntary. Potential candidates received a letter to solicit interest. The group of 24 properties were formally approved by Planning Commission and City Council.
- The effort included research and use of the Ohio Historic Inventory Forms.
- A future effort could take place using current tools (mapping, spreadsheet data) to identify candidates. Such effort could be taken on jointly by AHBR, HHA and City Staff.

Spacious historic home once part of Weohona Farm

HUDSON — Gail and Bill Cordier have spent the past 27 years in their home on Aurora Street enjoying its roomy and bright interior.

The colonial revival-style house has some 80 windows, which creates a well-lit environment.

"It is a bright, happy house," said Gail.

The home was built in 1910 by the McKenzie family, who resided in Cleveland and spent their summers in Hudson.

In 1918, the home and 125 acres purchased by Edward Fitch from Pennsylvania and called the Weohona Farm.

The property once also contained another home located near the driveway, which was later moved to 333 Aurora St.

Since its construction, the home has had seven owners.

"Most every family that has lived in this house has sent someone back to see us," Gail said.

The home is now one of 24 being recognized by the city as a historic landmark.

The Hudson Hub-Times has been featuring the landmarks each Wednesday.

Gail said when they first purchased the home in 1975, she wasn't sure what she would do with all the space.

"At that time, there were not many homes available in Hudson," Gail said. "It was important for us to be within walking distance of the downtown."

The house sits on a 4.3 - acre

lot and boasts roughly 5,000 square feet of living space.

"It is built like a fortress," Bill said.

It has undergone several changes over time, including the addition of a spacious master bathroom.

The Cordiers recently remodeled the kitchen, which Bill also helped to design.

They are currently working on the back yard patio and renovating a bedroom and bathroom on the third floor.

The property also contains a smokehouse and stables, and a small apartment housed in the garage.

"The story goes that the previous owner would go out there to the apartment to be by himself for awhile," said Bill.

Fireplaces, cupboards and bookcases are plentiful throughout the home.

Gail said it is a wonderful home for guests.

"We have gatherings here all the time," she said.

The pair should have a little more time to entertain, now that Bill recently retired from Cordier Group Holdings, his industrial holdings company.

Gail, however, is still busy serving as a driver for Hudson EMS, which she has done for the past 25 years.

The pair plans to finish their home renovation projects and keep enjoying the time spent in their historic home.

"We love the whole house," Bill said.

HUDSON — Valerie and Joe Czerwien had been living in a contemporary home in Macedonia when they decided to make a change.

"I wanted an old house and Hudson has old houses," Valerie said.

The Czerwiens ended up buying a historic home on Barlow Road.

"I just love the character of it," said Valerie.

The city of Hudson is recognizing 25 properties as historic landmarks. The *Hudson Hub-Times* has been profiling each one on Wednesdays.

The Czierwien home, built in 1838, was originally a farm house.

"I think there's a ghost here," Valerie said. "He was tall and thin and had farmer type clothes on."

"That's never happened to me before," Valerie said.

With their children grown and away from home, the three-bedroom home provides enough space when family, including Valerie's 11 brothers and sisters, comes to visit.


Other interesting details of the home include an array of woodwork and part of a slate roof that's used as a wall decoration in the kitchen.


