A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE SUMMIT COUNTY LAND BANK DISCRETIONARY GRANT FUND PROGRAM FOR ELIMINATING BLIGHTED PROPERTY AND FOR ADAPTIVE RE-USE THEREOF; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Summit County Land Bank's Discretionary Grant Fund Program offers funding support to local communities to support neighborhood and community reinvestment initiatives, including eliminating blight and returning properties to productive uses; and

WHEREAS, the City's Department of Public Works has made a recommendation to this Council for submission of a grant application to the Land Bank in the maximum amount that can be requested, \$25,000.00, for funds to cover the cost of demolition of a non-habitable house structure at 5810 Hudson Drive for the relocation of public school and City facilities; and

WHEREAS, a resolution of this Council is needed to authorize submission of a grant application for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized and directed to apply for the grant set forth in the preamble to this Resolution for an amount up to \$25,000.00.

Section 2. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare of the City, and for the further reason that the grant application is due to be submitted within thirty (30) days; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto, or six (6) affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
