

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH DUDE SOLUTIONS, INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES PERTAINING TO ASSET AND WORKFLOW MANAGEMENT SOFTWARE FOR CITY SERVICES OPERATIONS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, City Information Services and Public Works staff has reviewed eight (8) asset/work order management software solution packages for potential use in several departments of the City; and

WHEREAS, City staff has recommended that the City utilize Dude Solutions Inc. for said asset and work order management functions; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a contract to purchase Dude Solutions Inc. software for asset and work order management purposes, with an initial one-time up-front implementation and training services cost in the amount of \$17,200.00 and with a first-year annual maintenance and licensing contract cost of \$25,911.00 for an initial one (1)-year term at an annual negotiated subscription rate and subsequent automatic annual renewal terms, unless sooner terminated by the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The City Manager is authorized to enter into an agreement with Dude Solutions Inc. a professional software systems provider and support service provider, at the one-time up-front cost for implementation and the annual cost for the first year of the contract in a total amount not to exceed Forty-Three Thousand One Hundred Eleven Dollars (\$43,111.00), with automatic annual renewal terms thereafter in an amount as appropriated by this Council and in a form acceptable to the City Manager and City Solicitor.

Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
