A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ROAD SALT FROM CARGILL INC. THROUGH THE COMMUNITY UNIVERSITY AND EDUCATION PURCHASING ASSOCIATION PROGRAM FOR THE 2018-2019 WINTER SEASON; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson, as a member of the Community University and Education ("C.U.E.") purchasing program, may purchase road salt under the C.U.E.'s public bidding procedures; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has recommended purchasing of road salt through the C.U.E. program from Cargill Incorporated, of North Olmstead, Ohio, for the 2018-2019 winter season.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Hudson, Summit County, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>. For the 2018-2019 winter season, the City Manager is authorized to purchase the City's road salt requirements from Cargill Incorporated at \$79.82 per ton at a total cost not to exceed the amount budgeted and appropriated for such purchases of road salt for the Public Works Department.

<u>Section 2</u>. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 3. This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that the purchase of road salt is necessary to ensure safe driving conditions for the motoring public within the City of Hudson during the fast approaching winter season; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five (5) members of Council elected thereto, or six (6) affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
