OFFERED BY: MAYOR CURRIN

A RESOLTUION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR A POLICE VEHICLE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Hudson has the authority to purchase vehicles through the State of Ohio Cooperative Purchasing Program; and

WHEREAS, the City has obtained a price from Germain Ford of Columbus, Ohio, under the State of Ohio Procurement State Term Schedule Contract No. RS901213 for one patrol vehicle for the Police Department in the amount of \$25,244 in order to replace a patrol vehicle destroyed in an accident.

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Council of the City of Hudson, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

<u>Section 1</u>: The City Manager is authorized and directed to enter into and execute on behalf of the City of Hudson a purchase agreement with Germain Ford, Columbus, Ohio for one Ford NGPI-Utility vehicle for a total amount not to exceed \$25,244.

Section 2: This Resolution is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is immediately necessary to purchase the vehicle to maintain police protection and patrols in the City; wherefore, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, provided it receives the affirmative vote of five members of Council elected thereto or six affirmative votes if all members of Council are present at the meeting at which it is passed; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
